Motion to Approve minutes Debi and second Alexa Approved by voting members unanimously

- Review Minutes:
- Summer School: May 31- June 23
 - o recommendations made for JH and HS
 - JH at QC Junior High

- HS only for students who are failing or have failed at QCHS mixed in person and online
- more information coming in February
- Parent Satisfaction Survey: Due January 21st
 - o email to complete sent out and was in update from Mr. Gagnon
 - o covers everything school related for feedback
 - o survey results are used for comparative data between EHS & QCHS
 - results used from year to year to see improvements, declines, stagnant areas
 - o leadership (dept chair, admin) set goals to make improvements
 - comments are used
 - site council will review in February or March to elicit feedback for improvements
 - o last year had about 200 parents take out of 1100 students
- Participatory Budgeting Process
 - Center for Future of Arizona to get kids registered to vote and for budgeting
 - PB process is year long with lead out loud students brainstorming how to make campus welcoming or fix a current issue
 - surveyed the student body, take top 10 responses, determine as a group the top 3
 - research, contact contractors, presentation in front of governing board and district admin to show selection process and benefits to students
 - students watch campaigns after spring break and then get to vote on project they want completed
 - o focus really to show their vote matters
 - o bike racks, seating for lunch and murals around campus

Principal Report:

- Paul Gagnon -
 - Girls basketball won first round of playoffs will play Holbrook
 - o Boys wrestling Max Hawes 9th grader participating at the state meet
 - FBLA competed over 2 weeks: 1 first place in FBLA High School, Junior;
 1 first place FBLA Junior High, 8th grader
 - These can lead to scholarships for students
 - leads to state, regional and national competitions
 - virtual currently
 - o graduation meeting with senior parents on 2/15 for timeline and events
 - Mr. Ammon talked about events planned
 - 130 students in graduating class
 - GPA and SVE incoming 7th graders toured EHS
 - o Holocaust survivor spoke to students in 8th grade for their curriculum
