PSAT - the PSAT 8/9 and PSAT NMSQT (for High School) establishes a College readiness baseline. We highly recommend students in grades 8 through 11 take the test. We will be offering the PSAT on campus this October 28th. The cost is \$20 and available in the bookstore, **the deadline to purchase is September 14th.**
